Traditionally, the day begins with Eid salah (prayer), followed by heartfelt greetings, visiting family (especially elders), sharing festive meals and sweets, and giving to those in need. A key part of Eid is charity, including Zakat al-Fitr, so that everyone can share in the celebration. At its heart— Eid is a celebration of faith, mercy, community, and renewed intention.
