History & Significance

Traditions often include cleaning the home to "sweep away" old misfortune, decorating with red for good luck, sharing a reunion dinner, honoring ancestors, and giving red envelopes (hongbao) as a symbol of blessings and protection. From lanterns to lion/dragon dances, the season centers on one powerful idea: start the year with harmony, generosity, and auspicious intentions, so prosperity can follow you day by day.
